**BRADDOCK HEIGHTS HISTORICAL SOCIETY (BHHS)
NEWS AND INFORMATION**

The BHHS is continuing to work on a Braddock Heights walking tour that will highlight the history and homes of our wonderful community. As part of the tour, we are planning to erect several historical markers to commemorate our most treasured and important spots. We envision the tour to be self-guided using a pamphlet that includes a map, Braddock history, pictures, and even small ads for local businesses.

One of our planned markers will feature Casa Loma on Jefferson Boulevard. Casa Loma was originally built as a sanitarium by Rev. Charles Winbigler. Oscar Coblenz, one of the partners in the Frederick and Middletown Railway, occupied the home from 1910-1919. During the 1920's and 1930's it became an exclusive hotel under the ownership of French caterer Louis Guertin. Prominent Washington officials discovered Casa Loma and enjoyed great food, croquet, and wonderful views of the valley. Marshall Staub (owner of Staub's Liquor Store in Frederick) maintained the home for many years as a private residence, and was famous for his long and spirited parties. Since the mid 1960's, Casa Loma has been the family home to our beloved Frances Randall (long-time owner of the Frederick News Post). Frances has been a lifelong supporter of the BHHS and Frederick historical preservation.

The BHHS hopes the walking tour will provide a glimpse into Braddock Heights' history and showcase the beauty of our magnificent community.
