**D**ear Members - Summer finally arrived as defined by the high temperatures and humidity. Great to have a pool to go to. Our pool is the envy of a lot of Frederick people, not just Braddock Heights. The pool recently placed second in the Best of Frederick 2016 competition for swimming pools. We have had several complaints from pool members regarding "kiddie pool" overcrowding and a lack of parental supervision of children in the kiddie pool. Since lifeguards are not directly responsible for the kiddie pool, it is imperative parents/adults with children in the pool pay close attention to them. Guards have been instructed to ensure there is adequate supervision and take positive action where there are violations. We want everyone to enjoy their day/afternoon at the pool; however, where there is a lack of supervision and children misbehave, it ruins the experience for other children. On another note, starting September 1, 2016, the Braddock Heights Pavilion and Community Center will no longer be available for public rentals. These facilities will be reserved for Braddock Heights community

events only until such time as the Board completes its review of facilities usage and makes a final decision on the way ahead. These facilities are fully booked for August and those commitments will be honored. We regret this, however, coordinating the use of these facilities has become nearly a fulltime job for our volunteer, plus the costs for upkeep and maintenance are not matched by fees we charge. On a closing note, my term as President and Tom Dixon's term as Secretary end in November. We are looking for two dedicated Braddock Heights residents interested in serving our community to step forward and volunteer to fill these positions. There are other Board positions that need to be filled in November, as well. BHCA is only as good as the volunteers willing to serve. We need your help.
